

Westminster free clinic physician is honored

Steven D. Kamajian, D.O., was recently named Physician of the Year for 2003 by the Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons of California. The award is presented in recognition of community leadership and excellence in patient care.

In addition to his private practice as a family physician in Montrose for the last 22 years, Dr. Kamajian is medical director of Westminster Free Medi-

cal Clinics. (Health care service locations include Esseff Village classroom in Thousand Oaks and Westminster Presbyterian Church in Westlake Village, according to the Website.) He has been instrumental in developing free medical clinics that provide all aspects of medical care to the working poor and the homeless in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties.

At these clinic sites, in addition

to providing patient care, he has developed translation projects for the patients and teaching programs for high school, college and medical students, and has received multiple local and national awards from community and state organizations for his work.

Kamajian is president of the California chapter of the American Board of Osteopathic Practitioners.
